1. PEC meeting: BCBS came in with a 0% rate increase for the second year in a row. WRSD requested to open negotiations and proposed the following: change the split from 78/22 to 75/25, eliminate the HRA, reduce the buyout for employees getting health insurance elsewhere, and add a Short Term Disability Insurance Plan. All unions rejected the first three proposals and are willing to accept the last, with discussion of the carrier and a vote occuring on April 8th. MTA members can always get STD via MTA benefits program.
