### **Fund our Future Community Forum**

**Thursday, April 11, 2019** at WRHS auditorium, 6:00-7:30 pm, with light dinner Local Legislators will be in attendance.

Discussion will focus on educational funding needs and two pieces of legislation, being brought forward by the Mass Teachers Association:

- the **PROMISE Act** (K-12 funding)
- the **CHERISH Act** (Higher Ed. funding)

These bills support students and communities across the Commonwealth. Their focus is to address **shortfalls in funding** for special education, health insurance, low income and ELL students, funding that is owed to school districts, based on the **lack of updates to the Foundation Formula**, and they do so **WITHOUT** adding additional educator accountability parameters.

Share the importance of these bills with families and friends and keep pressure on the legislators who represent YOU. Let's get the right bills passed! Rep. Kim Ferguson sits on the committee, hearing these bills, and has not yet signed on with her support. Please join the WREA and other concerned community members at this IMPORTANT event!
