 - a. Discussion relative to intent of amendment: intent was to address related service provider members who travel between buildings and to provide them a voice at the HOD meetings that represent specific concerns of the related service provider group.
 - b. Aileen Thurber moved to amend the bylaw to include school psychologists in in the related service provider list.

- V. Discussion/adoption of the <u>2020/21 WREA proposed budget</u>
 - a. Conference expenses were not spent this year allowing the donation to the food pantry.
 - b. An expense for next year will be a new laptop.
 - c. Funds are available for release time for WREA President (if needed). This would be negotiated with the district.
- VI. Review/ratification of signed Memorandums of Agreement
 - a. <u>Teacher Mentor Stipend</u>
 - i. Moved, seconded and passed unanimously by voice vote
 - b. <u>CAGS Program</u>
 - i. Moved, seconded and passed unanimously by voice vote

 - a. <u>MOA amendment for COVID closure 5/26/2020</u> (approved by Eboard and HOD per bylaws; waiting for school committee approval)
 - i. Will be presented to the School Committee for consideration, next Mon, 6/8, and upon their approval it will come back to be signed.

- iii. Discussion around whether there was consideration for how members are selected for these assignments. (The answer was no.) There is a concern for equity of assignments. Could consider grieving over equity issue.
- iv. Passed unanimously by voice vote. We can now sign when the School Committee approves. It will sunset at the end of the school year.
- b. <u>Tentative Agreement on Furlough Day</u> related to WRSD budget for FY21
 - i. Member Survey Results were presented for each item on the survey
 - ii. Based on results, the only item to pass in the survey by a majority vote was to negotiate for 1 furlough day at this time.
 - iii. Presentation of 3 letters from towns stating they are NOT recommending the passing the Proposed FY20-21 WRSD Budget.
 - iv. Full MOA Moved and seconded
 - v. Moved and seconded to amend the MOA to include "In the event that the budget adopted by the five towns is less than \$99,518,867, the WREA agrees to the following:"
 - 1. First amendment passed unanimously by voice vote.
 - vi. Discussion around concern for loss of pd day.
 - vii. PD Committee (Linda Sasso and Kara Bolduc) advocating for PD to be provided via a remote or virtual platform or menu for people to choose from in their own time during the school year.
 - viii. Moved to add language to section A, to say, "The district will continue to offer no-cost PD to members equal to the 6 hours that the furlough day would have provided."
 - 1. Second Amendment moved, seconded and passed unanimously by voice vote
 - ix. Full MOA, as amended, passes by majority voice vote.
