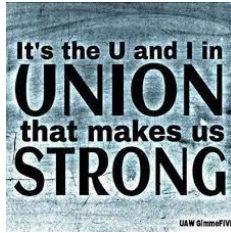

HVAC Report

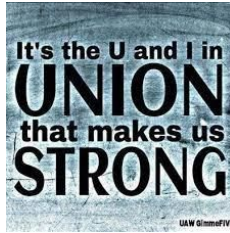
The HVAC report came in with a clean bill of health to the buildings in the early pages, however after looking closely at the report in the final attachment, of the air changes per hour (ACH) listed for the sample rooms tested eleven rooms were under the recommended ACH of 4:

- RM A11 at Dawson
- RM H10 at Houghton
- Green and Purple RMs at ECC
- RMs 2, 100, Art at Naquag,
- RMs 102, 103, 206, 207 at Paxton

My email to the superintendent about these numbers and my concerns is unanswered.
