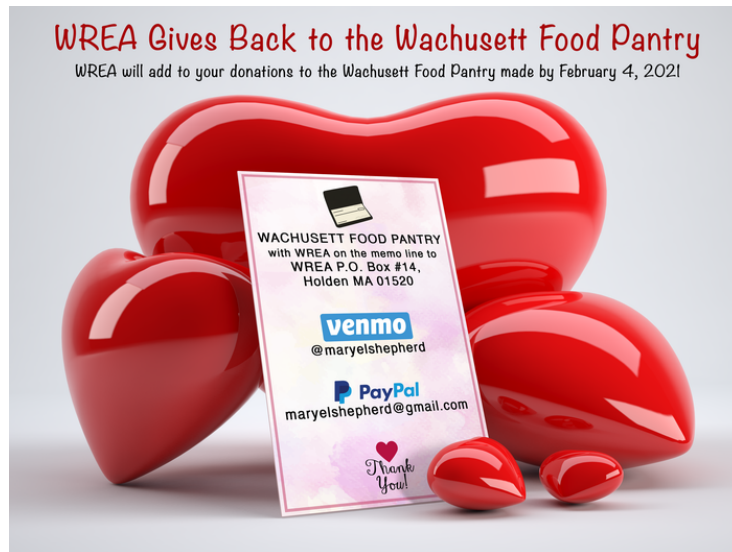
Reminders:
